CANCER SUPPORT MINISTRY

- A) Updates of CSM patients.

Ps 62: 5,6 "My soul, wait in silence for God only, for my hope is from Him, He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be shaken."

1. Clarissa Chan – Clarissa will start her radiation from 28th May till 4th June. Pray she will not have any side effects of the radiation and that her pain be manageable.
2. Aw Lay Tin – Recent CT scan after her surgery shows no more cancer cells in her breasts and lymph nodes. Praise the Lord for seeing her through more than 6 months of chemo and quick recovery from her surgery. She will start her radiation on 1st July for 15 sessions. Pray that her body will be able to cope with it with no side effects. Pray for good appetite, sleep well and good time management.
3. Soon Chong Guan – Thank God the tumour had shrunk after the chemo. He will be going for a major surgery on 9th June to remove all tumour in the stomach and affected areas. Pray for good outcome and that the surgeon will successfully remove all the affected part in the stomach and tumour in the surrounding area.
4. Peter See – Praise the Lord he is coping well. Pray that he will acknowledge our Lord Jesus as his Saviour and Lord and he will have a supernatural encounter with the Lord Jesus.
5. Poh Chin Teck – The last scan shows no more tumour in the colon, but the cancer marker is a bit high (7.4), which is beyond the normal range (below 4.8). He will need at least half of the total treatment till all microscopic cancer cells are gone. Praise the Lord that he is coping well. Pray for his salvation and that he will give glory to our Lord Jesus for the success of the treatment and healing.

B) CSM Talk on 24th Jul, Sat from 2pm to 3.30pm via zoom.

Col 3:17 “Whatever you do in the word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.”

2. **Pray for** Christians to be willing to receive criticisms and comments from others and be willing to be corrected and changed as part and parcel of their spiritual growth in Christ.
