3. **Pray that** we will honour God with our tithes and offerings and also honour our father and mother with the right attitude and action. (**Note:** One practical way to honour God is to set aside a decisive amount to be given wholeheartedly to the Lord for tithes and offerings on a regular basis. One practical way to honour our parents is to spend time with them, communicating with them and confiding in them.)
4. **Pray that** we will obey the Great Commission to bring the Gospel to the unreached. (**Note:** One practical way to obey God's command is to share our faith in Christ readily to where the Lord our God has placed us in. That is the best place to begin with.)
