OUTREACH PILLAR

REV LEE KIEN SENG

1. Thank God for seeing Gavriel through his PSLE. Pray for wisdom to choose a suitable secondary school for him to continue to develop as a youth.
2. Thank God for seeing Gaius through his first reservist training and for protection as he learnt to drive an armour vehicle.
3. Pray for Gracia that she will have the wisdom to disciple her Sec 1 girls and to bond them together in spite of having to meet them often over Zoom.
4. Pray for general good health for the family so that we can continue to be up and about, ministering to people whom the Lord puts in our pathways.

MISSION MINISTRY

Prayer for Mission Committee

1. Pray for wisdom and God's guidance for the Mission Committee, as they review and refine the plans for 2022, as well as look at better ways to support our local and overseas missionaries.
2. Pray for our missionaries to be able to find creative ways to engage the non-believers, amidst the COVID restrictions.

Prayer for Missionary - Pannee (Thailand)

1. Pray for the approval from the authority to install three-phase electric power for the church building project.
2. Pray for the faith of the new believers to be strong in following God and to come for worship at the church on Sundays.
3. Pray for the church members' beliefs and their well-being due to COVID.
4. Pray for the students in the two schools near the church as well as the villagers to come for worship when the church is open.

THAI SERVICE

1. Pray that all members will thirst for God in their personal devotion every day.
2. Pray for members, who have not joined any DG, prayer group and Bible study group, to be able to manage their time to join such groups for their spiritual growth and fellowship (through Line & Zoom).
3. Pray that all members will be active to attend the online or the onsite services.
4. Pray for the church members' beliefs and their well-being due to COVID.

5. Pray for the outreach programme: Teaching English to Thai People. Pray that the students may open their heart to the Gospel and in God's time, receive Jesus as their Saviour and Lord.

EVANGELISM MINISTRY

1. For the upcoming Angel Tree project, pray that 20 pairs of our church members will volunteer for it. As the volunteers visit the families of the inmates to deliver the gift cards and letters, pray for favour and that our engagement efforts would bring joy and happiness to the families.
2. Pray that our church members will have the opportunity to share the Christmas story with their non-Christian friends, colleagues, and family members during the upcoming Christmas season. Pray for DGs to think of creative ways to share the gospel either online or in their small group gatherings.

STREET EVANGELISM (St. E)

1. Pray for the St. E team to make use of the Online Outreach Resources on True Way website to connect with their contacts, in "walking across the room" to initiate spiritual conversation with them via phone call or text message.
2. Pray for the St. E team to share their evangelistic encounters with other worshippers so as to spur them to desire to connect with their contacts in reaching them for the Lord Jesus.
3. Pray for the hearts of the people to be open and receptive to the sharing of the St. E team. Pray that, in due time, they will give their hearts to the Lord Jesus.

FOLLOW-UP MINISTRY – ABC/SCL CLASSES

1. Thank God for the successful completion of the first Group-based ABC class (Part 2) via Google Hangouts on 9 September, where there were 6 participants.
2. Thank God for the successful commencement of the first SCL class via Google Hangouts on 27 September, where there were 4 participants. Pray for these 4 participants to learn and grow in their faith in Christ through this form of Bible Study.
3. Pray for ABC leaders to reach out to those who need the basics of the Christian faith and encourage them to consider participating in any ABC class in time to come.
4. Pray for ABC leaders to encourage those who have attended ABC class to proceed to participate in SCL class so that their faith in Christ may be further strengthened. (Note: We do not have SCL leaders at this moment.)
5. Pray for worshippers to be receptive to participating in ABC classes via virtual means if they desire to grow in their Christian faith.

FOLLOW-UP MINISTRY – BIBLE CORRESPONDENCE CLUB (BCC)

1. Pray for God's direction for the future of this BCC ministry.
2. Pray for God's provision of more students for the BCC Courses.
3. Pray for markers to prayerfully consider introducing other online sound-doctrine Bible Courses to their students to consider doing during this period of COVID-19 situation.
4. Pray for markers and students to be able to relate with each other in a deeper manner, perhaps

through text messaging. In so doing, this may create an opportunity for the markers to know their students better and then, introduce them to Christ.

BOYS BRIGADE MINISTRY

1. Pray for wisdom for the Officers as they plan how to conduct CCA meaningfully on the online platform until physical CCA sessions are allowed again.
2. Pray for healing and encouragement for one of our Sec 4 Boys, who is suffering from some serious health complications after his 2nd dose of the vaccine. He is determined to complete his GCE O Level examinations and is in the midst of undertaking it.
3. Thank God for the successful completion of the BB programme for the past year despite the many disruptions caused by the heightened alert period and the current suspension of CCA.

CARE CLUB MINISTRY

1. Pray for care club volunteers to have passion to continue to serve for 2022, and opportunity to share the gospel with the children.
2. Pray that the children will be able to adjust well to the new structure in year 2022 and will be faithful in attending hybrid session via Zoom and onsite.

GUITAR OUTREACH MINISTRY

1. Pray for speedy resumption of our fortnightly guitar jam sessions & our beginners' guitar classes.
2. Pray that volunteers will continue to serve with passion & commitment when guitar sessions resume.
3. Pray that the interests for members of the guitar group will be sustained.
4. Pray for creative & innovative ideas to share the gospel with the members.

UKULELE MINISTRY

2. Pray that the Teacher Family Retreat on National Day can be run and the return to normal routine and activities next year.

SENIOR CARE MINISTRY

1. Thank God for good attendance for the Friday weekly Devotional for Seniors/ Homebodies via Zoom. Pray for more Truewayians to join the session as most of the attendees are seniors of the ukulele ministry.
2. Pray for more young people to be volunteers for the Meals-On-Wheel as senior volunteers are told to stop due to MOH's advisory.

PRAY FOR SINGAPORE

Pray for Singapore: Christians - "Not to Slander or Judge One Another."

Do not speak evil against one another, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor? James 4:11-12 ESV

The words of a whisperer are like delicious morsels; they go down into the inner parts of the body. Proverbs 18:8 ESV

Whoever slanders his neighbour secretly I will destroy. Whoever has a haughty look and an arrogant heart I will not endure. Psalm 101:5 ESV

For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another. Galatians 5:14-15 ESV

Food for Thoughts:

The word "slander" means "to speak against someone, either to his face or behind his back." Gossip, backbiting, accusing, and defaming are all forms of slander. The word is repeatedly used of those who grumbled against Moses in the wilderness. (see Numbers 12:1-16; 21:4-9). Slander is a despicable sin, an arrogant breach of love. This area of theology is so vast, so basic, and yet so neglected. No wonder James repeatedly brings it up in his letter. Remember this: God forbids slandering. (see Leviticus 19:16).

Prayers:

1. Pray that Christians will confess and repent of their sins of slandering or judging others, and that they will have an utter disgust and distaste for all forms of slandering.
2. Pray that Christians will consider seriously the consequences of their actions and that they will not undermine the authority which God has placed over them in the church.
3. Pray that Christians will consult God, His Word and His Spirit, in order to know whether they have violated the Law of the Kingdom, that is, love God and love neighbour, and also in order to know the root issues of slandering in their lives.
4. Pray that Christians will not speak evil against the pastors, the elders, the deacons, or even against anyone whom they are not happy with, but that they may be gracious, kind and loving in their speech and their conduct towards one another in the Community of Believers, the Community of Faith.
