Food for Thought:

When you are in great distress, what shall you do? “Praying to God” should be our proper response. When you are sick, who shall you call? According to this Bible passage, you are instructed to call for the elders of the church. In our today’s context, it is different. You may call upon the leaders of the church, may it be the pastors, elders or deacons or even DG leaders. Of course, we recognise the authority bestowed on the elders of the church. Besides this, the attitude of the heart is more important than the material used for prayer, say oil, in this instance. We pray in the name of Jesus and trust God to administer the healing according to His divine will and purpose.

Prayers:

1. God’s faithfulness. Pray that Christians will trust in the great faithfulness of God. Pray also that they will place their faith in a faithful God who hears and who heals.
2. God’s goodness. Pray that Christians will exhibit God’s goodness in their lives, willing to pray for those who are in great distress. Pray that Christians will be grateful to God for His goodness in many aspects of their daily lives. Pray that when there is opportunity, they will not withhold good from those to whom it is due. (See Proverbs 3:27).
3. God’s sovereignty: Pray that Christians will learn, know and understand the Sovereignty of God, recognising that not every sickness or illness is healed but at the same time, realising that God has placed His leaders in the church for His divine will and purpose. Pray that Christians will see the relevance of prayer and that prayer is the strengthening of the faith of the believers in Christ.
