PRAY FOR SINGAPORE

Pray for Singapore Christians — "To Be Prayerful At All Times."

Read and Ponder:

James 5:16b-18 ESV, ". . . The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working. Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again, and heaven gave rain, and the earth bore its fruit."

Food for Thought:

Who was that righteous person in this Bible text? Elijah, the prophet of God, was that man who prayed. A righteous person is not a super-saint but one who hears the Word of God and does it. (See James 1:22-25) Let us be **doers of the Word** and be **faithful in prayer**. We need to know the Word of God in order to pray in accordance with the Will of God. The one who have a close relationship with God will know what to intercede for the things that matter to God. Let us pray that our spiritual eyes be open so as to be prayerful at all times.

Prayers:

1. **Pray that** Christians will live lives in a manner which is right and pleasing in the sight of God and men. **Pray also that** they will know the Word of God well so that they may know what to pray for when situation calls for it. **Pray also that** they will stand up against the injustices, immoralities and idolatries of this generation. **Pray also that** the Christian Community will give priorities to the reading of the Word and the intercession of prayer.
